1 PSTN Payphones

PSTN ('Fixed line') Payphones are standard Payphones that are connected to the Spark PSTN Network. PSTN Payphones are installed at fixed Payphone sites accessible to the general public where there is a PSTN network available.

³ Calls from Scott & McMurdo base to New Zealand are charged at \$2.00 per minute. Other call charges (local and international) are as per normal payphone charges.

⁴ Credit cards must not be inserted into payphones. The service is accessible by dialling 08390 or 08342. Tariff can be obtained by pressing 0.

2 Cellular Payphones

Cellular Payphones are standard Payphones that are connected to the Spark Cellular Network. Cellular Payphones are installed on mobile sites (e.g. inter-island ferries, fishing vessels, Payphone trailers) or at fixed sites where there is no fixed (PSTN) network available.

3 Additional and Other Charges

3.1 Operator-Assisted Calls

There is a charge in addition to the applicable call rate where the caller uses the services of an operator. These additional charges are:

International Collect Calls	Prices set by carrier in the destination country
National Operator Connected (Station to Station) call	\$3.99
National Person-to-Person calls	\$3.99
